

## Digging Deeper

**Sermon:** THE VALLEY OF DRY BONES

**Scripture:** Ezekiel 37:1-14



### GETTING STARTED

Describe a time in your life when you felt spiritually and/or emotionally “dry”.  
What helped you to regain hope?

### BIBLE STUDY

1. Read Ezekiel 37:1-3 and answer these questions.
  - What evidence is presented to confirm that Ezekiel’s presence in this valley was a part of God’s will?
  - How are the bones described?
    - What do these bones represent?
  - Does Ezekiel’s response to the Lord’s question in verse 3 indicate a lack of faith in God?
2. Read Ezekiel 37:4-6 to answer the following questions.
  - What does God instruct Ezekiel to do?
  - What does God say He will do for the bones?
    - For what purpose is God going to do this (v. 6)?
3. Read Ezekiel 37:7-10. Why did the bones not come to life right away?
4. As you read through verses 11-14, underline the number of things that God says He will do for and to the people of Israel & Judah.

### APPLY IT

If you are presently in a “dry” period of your life, write out some specific lessons that you can take away from this lesson to help you get back to a place of fruitfulness and hope.

- Be sure to consider the role of God’s Word and God’s Spirit in this effort.

If you are not presently in a “dry” period of your life, write out some lessons you have learned from this lesson that will be helpful to reflect on during those “dry” times that will inevitably arise in the future.
