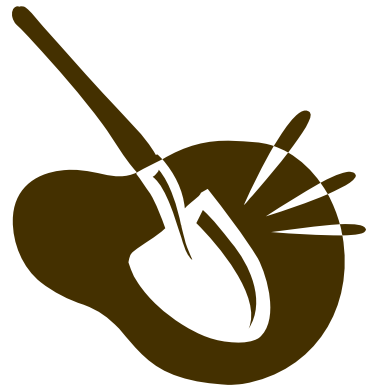


## DIGGING DEEPER

### Getting Started

Discuss the impact that a Godly mentor has had on your life. This could be a family member, friend, neighbor, pastor, etc.

### Bible Study Questions

1. What do you suppose Paul had in mind when he referred to the "sincere faith" of Timothy's grandmother and mother (verse 5)?
2. Read Deuteronomy 6:6-9 and identify the verbs that describe the way that we are to instruct our children in spiritual matters.
3. Look up 2 Timothy 3:14-15.
  - What does Paul mean in v. 14 when he talks about being obedient to the Word "because you know those from whom you learned it."?
  - What role does Scripture play in our salvation, according to verse 15?
4. How does Hebrews 11:1 define "faith"?
  - How does this type of faith differ from mere "hope so" religion?

### Apply It

As a Group, discuss ways in which each of us can serve as a mentor or a "faith-model" to others.
