3. Read the following passages of those who gave their testimonies about their relationship with Jesus. Sum up their testimony in one or two sentences.
 - John 9:13-25:
 - John 4:39-41:
4. Read Psalm 145:4-7. What verbs are used in addition to or instead of “testify” to describe the manner in which the Psalmist will convey what God has done for him?
 - What does this suggest about the forms our testimonies can take?

APPLY IT

Write out a testimony that you can share with someone else. It might be the testimony of your salvation—how you came to know Christ as your Savior. Or it could be a testimony of something that God has done in your life—a time when you felt especially close to Him or comforted by Him in sorrow. Make it personal and make it real.
