Getting Started

1. Why did Peter initially act so adamantly about not eating food that Jews considered unclean when God first revealed Himself in Peter's vision (Acts 10:9-15)?
2. Why do you suppose it took God three times before the message sunk into Peter (v. 16)?
3. Although not many Jews apparently understood that God intended to reach out to non-Jews all along, what truth does Paul teach in Galatians 3:8-9 to emphasize that God always meant to reach Gentiles as well as Jews?
4. Read Ephesians 2:11-22. In the left hand column, write those words and phrases that describe us prior to salvation, and in the right hand column, write the words and phrases that describe us after we are saved:
