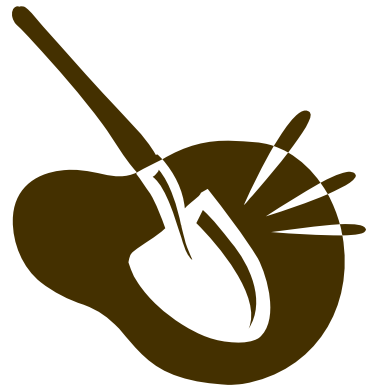

Bible Study Questions

1. Read Exodus 3:7-12. Does Moses reply to God in verse 11 surprise you?
 - Why or why not?
 - What is the significance of God's response to Moses' objection in verse 12?
2. Why did God get so angry with Moses (Exodus 4:14)?
 - What lesson should we learn from this?
3. Look up 1 Corinthians 12:27-31. What lessons do we learn about serving God through these verses?
4. While Moses made many excuses to try to get out of doing what God wanted him to do, how is Moses described in Deuteronomy 34:5-12?

Apply It

As you consider the various opportunities for service that exist at Life Spring, give prayerful consideration as to whether God is leading you to fill one of these spots. If you have reservations, write them down and pray over them. Are they legitimate concerns, or are they just excuses to keep you from experiencing God's blessings?
