3. What did God mean when He said that **the battle is not yours, but God's** (v. 15)?
4. Read verses 22-24. How did things turn out for Jehoshaphat's enemies?
5. As you look back on the story of Jehoshaphat, why do you think prayer played such an integral role in their victory?
