## GETTING STARTED

As you consider the last year of ministry at Life Spring, what have we done as a church that, in your opinion, has really given praise and honor to God?

## BIBLE STUDY

1. What do the following verses teach us about “the place of praise”?
  - Genesis 35:1
  - Deuteronomy 12:5-7
  - Psalm 149:1
  - Hebrews 10:25
  - John 4:19-24
2. So in light of the above Scriptures and Psalm 150:1, how would you respond to someone who said, “I don’t go to church because I can worship God any place I want”?
3. Read Psalm 147:1-20. What do we read in these verses about “What God Has Done?”
  - Why would the recitation of all of these works of God encourage us to praise and worship Him?
4. Read Psalm 145:7-9. What do we learn in these verses about “Who God Is”—about his characteristics and attributes?
  - How does knowing these things about the character of God influence our praise of Him?
5. The Psalms we have studied in this series have expressed a wide range of emotions on the part of the Psalmists. This Psalm is devoted entirely to praise. Why would you think that this is this an appropriate way for the Book of Psalms to conclude?

## APPLY IT

Write down 7 specific things for which you can give God praise. Each day in the coming week, devote a few moments to praising God for one of the things on your list. Don’t just thank Him for these things, but truly offer praise to Him for them.
