### Getting Started

Describe a worship service that you have attended that impacted you greatly? What was it about the service that you remember? Why?

### Bible Study Questions

1. What does it mean to worship the Father:
  - “in spirit”?
  - “in truth”?
    - Why are both characteristics necessary to worship in a manner pleasing to God?
2. Read Psalm 63, a Psalm written by David as he flees from the rebellion initiated by his son Absalom. Answer the following questions from this Psalm.
  - Based on what David says in these verses, how would you describe his relationship with God?
  - The word “soul” is used three times (in the NIV). What do each of these verses say about David’s soul, and what does that suggest upon David’s relationship with God?
    - verse 1
    - verse 5
    - verse 8
  - In verse 2, David speaks of what he has “seen”, and in verse 6 of what he “remember[ed]”. How does what David has “seen” and “remembered” affect his attitude about the future (vv. 9-11)?

### Apply It

How should your routine leading up to Sunday worship change to help you to prepare more appropriately for worship (e.g. getting up earlier on Sunday morning, spending time in prayer)?
